Additionally, it is estimated that half of all sharps injuries go unreported. The impact of a sharps injury can be immense – from potential exposure to blood borne pathogens to the direct and in-direct costs of an incident.

While scalpel blade injuries are among the most frequent sharps injuries, second only to needle sticks, adoption of safety scalpels in surgery has significantly lagged behind adoption of other safety devices. It's time to introduce safer scalpels that surgeons like to use.
